* MANAGEMENT BACKGROUND

The Union Education Society is an educational society registered under the Society's Registration Act of 1860 and is also a Public Trust registered under Bombay Public Trust Act 1950.

In pursuance with its aims & objectives the society has set-up 4 educational institutions right from Pre-primary to Graduate level in the field of Arts

To impart formal and informal education to the children of the minority community in Solapur city Late Mr. Abdul Karim Bawalal Vakil, a noted advocate and Muslim Leader took initiative and set up an educational institution under the name and style of "UNION EDUCATION SOCIETY, SOLAPUR." In the year 1944, the eminent personalities who associated with him for this venture extended their co-operation and invested their money, labour, energy, time and devoted their life for establishing the institution in this soil. As a result this institution is seen today as well developed and well established Muslim Institution in Solapur region which imparts education right from K.G. Classes to graduation.

The educational activities of the institution started with the establishment of M.A. pangal Anglo Urdu High School, Solapur in 1963. After establishment of Primary

Junior colleges for girls and boys for imparting education in Urdu medium. Consequently M. A. Pagnal Anglo Urdu Junior College and Begum Qamarunnisa Karigar Girls Junior College came into existence in the year 1975 and 1983 respectively. Naturally, in due course of time it became a dream of the Management to set up a Senior College for girls' in Solapur. At last the dream came true in the year 1989 and a senior college came into existence under the name and style of "U.E.S. Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Solapur". The main architect of this senior college was late Mr. Abdul Aziz Sultan Saheb Shaikh, ex-President of the Union Education Society, Solapur. Within a brief span of time it has become a full

fledged college imparting education to the girls' in Arts faculty from B.A. Part-I to B.A. Part - III level. This is the only Mahila Mahavidyalaya in the vicinity of the Solapur University, Solapur, having its centre for teaching Urdu subject at graduation level. Moreover the college has a provision for teaching all the subjects in English and Marathi medium even though, majority of the girls come from Urdu background. Despite of it the results are meritorious. Students are securing various Scholarship every year. This itself indicates that the college has high standard of teaching.

GUIDELINE OF ADMISSION

Parents / Students are requested to go through the guidelines given below and also see the notices put up on the College notice board before seeking admission. The admissions to the college shall be subject to the following terms and conditions.

- Students should personally take admissions and use only the prescribed forms allotted by the college.
- Admission committee for each class helps the students in making proper choice of optional subjects.
- All admissions shall be provisional and subject to confirmation by the principal and university.
- Admissions are made on the basis of merit.

Students who seek admission in this college, should adhere to the following rules and regulations strictly.

If she remains absent continuously for a long period she will immediately be informed by the letter, and if she fails to respond to the letter her name shall be struck off from the college register without any further

- correspondence. In such case she will not be liable to claim for EBC/BC /ST/SC or any other Govt. facility and the college has power to recover her fees.
- She shall not be allowed to fill in the examination form & appear for the examination unless she completes at least 75% days attendance during the academic year.
- 3) Admission shall not be made of such students for the next academic year in the same class whose name is struck off for the above reasons.
- If any of the statement made in application form or any information supplied by the student in connection with her admission is later on, at any time found to be false or incorrect her admission will be cancelled.

RULES OF DISCIPLINE

- Students should be regular and punctual in attending classes tutorials and unit tests. Terms shall not be granted and a student shall not be certified for examination if her progress, conduct and attendance is not satisfactory.
- Students if found indulging in anti national activities contrary to the provisions of the Acts and laws enforced by Government will be liable to be expelled from the
- Ragging of students in any form within or outside the college is strictly prohibited. Defaulters will be strictly dealt with as per Govt, instructions in this matter.
- 4) Bicycle, Scooters and Vehicles should be parked only in (6)

areas provided for the purpose. The college accepts no responsibility for their safe custody.

- Any changes in the address of the student must be intimated by her in writing to the college office immediately.
- A student must carry Identity card signed by the principal and produce the same whenever asked by the college authorities. Without Identity card, students will not be allowed to enter the college premises and will be strictly dealt with.
- 7) A student is expected to read the notices put up on the notice board of the college. The college accepts no responsibility for loss of any advantages by student due to failure to read the notice in time.
- Any damage to the college property, apparatus, furniture equipment, library books, buildings etc. must be paid for immediately by the students.
- 9) Students must attend Social and National functions organised by the college such as 26th January and 15th August and all other declared National celebrations.
- 10) Writing on benches or walls is strictly prohibited.
- 11) A student will be bound by the rules and regulations formed by the college from time to time.
- 12) Students are strictly prohibited to bring mobile phone in the college premises.
- 13) Uniform is Compulsory to all the students.

14) Strict disciplinary action will be taken against any students who fails to comply with any of the above instructions.

IMPORTANT SUGGESTIONS

- 1) The students should bear in mind that merely paying the fee in the college is not enough to claim their right to fill up the examination form. They will have to fulfill the conditions laid down by the college and the University from time to time.
- 3) The students should take enough care to fill up different forms for different purposes from time to time otherwise, they will be held responsible for their own loss and not the college.
- 4) The students should maintain cleanliness in the college premises.
- 5) The students are free to record any constructive suggestions either in the college office or in the managements office.
- The students should always keep extra copies of the documents submitted in the office for their reference.
- The students should collect the original Mark list and passing Certificate from the college office within a short span of time.

Fee Concession:

A number of deserving students are granted fee concessions.

Evaluation of students:

To evaluate the performance of the students the college conducts 1st Term and IInd term internal exams, Unit Tests, Tutorials, Oral and Project Works.

Gymkhana:

Fitness of the women is of vital importance in a vibrant society, for they are the future mothers who will through their guidance eventually determine the destiny of our nation. With this prime objective in our mind the college has developed a separate Gymkhana with all sports amenities for the students & a huge play ground where girls feel free, safe & secure to play and participate in various indoor & outdoor games.

The Gymkhana Committee of the college has a qualified Director of Physical education, taking care of the needs of the students for various sports activities. Students are encouraged to participate in various sports at inter-collegiate, University State & National levels. Our teams have participated in inter-collegiate & competition For eg. Table - Tennis, Bad Menton, Atheletics, Chess, Carrom, Volley Ball etc.

The Students are provided with tracksuits, shoes, athletic kit etc.

The college has an N.S.S. unit of 150 volunteers which has a regular as well as special camping programme at the adopted village.

Anti-ragging Cell:

In view of the judgement and order 11.02.2009 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India the college has established an Anti-Ragging Cell. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the college authorities, the accused student will be given an opportunity to explain and if her explanation is not satisfactory, the authority would expel her from the institution. The college has "Zero Tolerance" towards ragging.

The college has placed Suggestion Box" to address the grievances of the students.

Career Guidance Cell

The college has established a Separate Career Guidance cell. Due care has been taken for shaping the career of the student during their graduation with the help of the CAREER GUIDANCE CELL. The experts in various fields are invited to guide, council & help select proper career for the students.

English Literary Association:

The college has English department hence English literary Association is formed. Various activities are carried out for the improvement of spoken and written knowledge of English language among the students.



Urdu Literary Association:

As Urdu is taught up to graduate level, Urdu Literary Association has been established. Mushairas, Quawalis and Ghazal Singing programmes are arranged. The lectures on Urdu Literature by Scholars are also arranged.

Hindi Literary Association:

A separate Literary Association of Hindi and Marathi have been formed to create interest in the national and regional languages respectively.

Bhugol Abhyas Mandal:

The college has a Bhugol Abhyas Mandal where all the students who offer Geography as a optional subject are enrolled. They visit places of geographical importance and excursion and tours are organised for them. The Bhugol Mandal also organises seminars, symposia at district and state level, where the teachers and students get benefit of geographical knowledge and information.

Cultural Committee:

The committee is formed to develop the artistic talent in the students. Students who are interested in singing, acting and dancing art etc. are provided full opportunities to develop this aspect in their personality.

Wall-Paper Literature:

Students, who are good at writing are encouraged to write articles, stories and compose poems of their own on different topics of their choice in Urdu, English, Marathi and Hindi. Their literature put up on the notice boards for other students.

Internal Complaints Committee (ICC):

Sexual harassment as defined in the Sexual harassment of women at workplace (Prevention, prohibition and redressal) Act, 2013includes any one or more of the following 'Unwelcome' acts or behaviour: (i) physical contact and advances; (ii) a demand or request for sexual fevers; (iii) making sexually coloured remarks; (iv) showing pornography; or (v) any other unwelcome physical, verbal or non-verbal conduct of sexual nature. Further, the following may show amount to sexual harassment; (i) implied or explicit promise of preferential treatment; (ii) implied or explicit threat about present or future employment treatment; (iii) implied or explicit threat about present or future employment status; (iv) interference with work or creating an intimidating or offensive or hostile work environment; or (v) humiliating treatment likely to affect health or safety.
